We know that patient demand for joint surgery, comprehensive cancer care, and access to specialized care is top of mind for residents of Somerset County. As the only hospital in Somerset County, it is critical that we are able to keep pace with the changing healthcare needs of our neighbors, reducing the need for patients to travel for care. True to our mission, we are evolving to meet the needs of our community at RWJUH Somerset. This means creating a destination for care with our Orthopedic Center of Excellence and expansion of the Steeplechase Cancer Center, along with expansion of our Eating Disorders Unit and the Babs Siperstein PROUD Center. In addition to this growth, we will be converting the majority of the hospital to private patient rooms and expanding our technology to elevate the patient experience. New construction and renovation is a powerful investment to elevate RWJUH Somerset to respond to the future healthcare needs of our community.





MISSION MOMENTS



RWJUH Somerset recently unveiled plans for a two-story, 76,600-square-foot vertical expansion above the hospital's existing Orthopedics Pavilion and Emergency Department (ED) building. The space will house the new Orthopedic Center of Excellence, which will include 35 fully private patient rooms and a state-of-the-art rehab gym for orthopedic patients, and an ED Rapid Decision Unit. The self-contained Orthopedic Center of Excellence will ensure that joint surgery patients can receive the highest quality pre-and post-operative care close to home, eliminating the need for patients to travel. Patients will experience privacy and comfort through 35 thoughtfully furnished private inpatient rooms featuring amenities such as convertible sleeper sofas, USB ports and work services, and a state-of-the-art rehabilitation gym. The expansion will also include a 10-room Rapid Decision Unit for RWJUH Somerset's ED. Patients who require additional observation or are waiting for test results will occupy these rooms, helping reduce wait times in the ED providing increased comfort for patients and their families.



Our Diabetes Center recently moved to a newly renovated space just off the hospital's main lobby. The modern center features amenities such as telehealth capabilities and smart televisions which patients can use to view supportive visual material. Our Diabetes Center helps patients manage their diabetes through one-on-one counseling, blood glucose monitoring, meal planning and nutritional counseling, exercise planning, and insulin pump therapy. A gestational diabetes program is also available for those with diabetes only during pregnancy.



The second phase of our Eating Disorders Unit renovation is complete and we received approval from the New Jersey Department of Health to move patients into the new inpatient space. The next phase of construction has begun and when completed later this year, it will expand the number of patient rooms from 14 to 20. Adults and adolescents will be separated. The unit features a calming aesthetic to create a relaxing environment that promotes healing.
