You may be assigned more than one patient



Typical assignment: Elderly who wander, patients with occasional memory loss, confusion, prior history of falls, behavioral health units

	Make sure the patient has everything they need during your check in: Call bell Phone Access to water (if allowed) Offer toileting	15/30 minutes. What can I help you with?
	Be mindful not to get distracted with other patients; seek assistance to remain on time with the watch	I have a safety concern I'd like to share an observation from
	Document your observations	today
	Escalate any concerns or issues to the patient's care team	
	Provide a thorough and structured handoff	During my shift, this is what happened/what I noticed This is what you should be aware of

You are so vital to each patients' safety, even a few minutes' delay in checking in can be unsafe.
