RWJUH Hamilton's other specialties include heart and vascular care, including emergency and elective angioplasty; a heart failure intervention program, coupled with specialty-trained support staff; treatment and care for minor injuries and life-threatening illnesses; outpatient diagnostic and treatment services and medical/surgical services; bariatric surgery; wound care; women's health; geriatrics/senior health and wellness care; infusion services; and outpatient rehabilitation and physical therapy centers, including cardiac rehab, orthopedic rehab, speech therapy, aquatic therapy, a balance and hearing center, and sleep center.


