## **Re-entry Application for Generic and LPN-RN Track**

Students are responsible to read all requirements carefully.

Students who have not maintained the published sequence of nursing curriculum courses are required to seek re- entry. Once a student is out of sequence with the NURE courses, there is no guarantee of re-entry back into the course.

The break in sequence may be due to:

- Course withdrawal
- Course failure
- Students who have successfully passed a nursing course, but have chosen not to enroll into the next NURE course

### Important eligibility requirements to apply for Re-entry:

- There is no guarantee of a seat for any re-entry applicant.
- ▲ A minimum Union College GPA of 2.5 is required.
- Students with more than two NURE course withdrawals are not eligible for re-entry.
- Students who have two NURE course failures are not eligible for re-entry consideration. The following exceptions apply:
  - Students with two NURE course failures who are applying to return to the last course in the Generic or LPN-RN may apply for Re-admission. The re-admission policy can be found in the Trinitas School of Nursing Handbook.

#### Generic RN students

 Not enrolled in a NURE course for three consecutive semesters will need to apply for entrance to TSON and follow curriculum sequence.

#### LPN-RN students

 Not enrolled in a NURE course for more than one year who have not been enrolled in a nursing course for more than <u>1 year</u> will need to apply for entrance to TSON and follow curriculum sequence.

## Available re-entry seats are offered in the following order:

- Students who have withdrawn from a course due to an approved extenuating circumstance (Approval of the Dean is required, along with documentation supporting extenuating circumstance).
  - a. Submit documentation of extenuating circumstance with re-entry application.
- Out of sequence students and students applying after course failure/course withdrawal, ranked in GPA order.

#### **How to Submit Re-entry Application**

- Submit completed application by <u>email only</u> to <u>trinitas@ucc.edu</u> including attachments as PDF.
   Must include:
  - 1. Current unofficial Union College transcript.
  - 2. Signed application.
- Once your application is evaluated, you will receive a confirmation email.
- Applications must be accepted by dates below.

# **Re-entry Decision Information:**

- Re-entry decisions are made once regular course registration is completed. Re-entry seats are normally offered within one week of regular course registration date
- Decision emails will be sent directly to your OWL email address

## **Upon Acceptance**

- All applicants accepted for re-entry MUST accept their seat by date listed on acceptance email.
- All applicants accepted MUST follow Clinical Requirements for Re-entry, as posted on the website under "Students applying for Re-entry."
