

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, mental illnesses are among the most common health conditions in the United States, with more than 1 in 5 adults living with a mental illness.

To better serve these patients in need, Monmouth Medical Center Southern Campus (MMCSC) announced the opening earlier this spring of a new Medical Behavioral Specialty Unit, an eight-bed medical surgical unit dedicated to the comprehensive care of patients with behavioral health needs.

The unit is staffed with a dedicated team of nurses, clinical care technicians, and mental health associates trained in both medical, surgical and behavioral health to provide appropriate care for hospitalized adults with medical and psychiatric illnesses.

"These patients may have underlying medical diseases such as heart disease or diabetes or needs that are underserved due to their behavioral health conditions that require specialty surgery that often go untreated," said MMCSC Chief Administrative Officer Philip Passes, DO. "Monmouth Medical Center Southern Campus has created a specialty nursing unit to meet all of their health care needs in a nurturing and safe environment. We are very excited about this opportunity to deliver exceptional care to those who need it the most in our community and throughout the RWJBarnabas Health system."






The Monmouth Medical Center Southern Campus **Wall of Hope**







